- In kind donations from community average approximately \$3400 annually.
 These items include groceries, hygiene products, linens, cleaning supplies.
- There are 10 provincially funded shelters and 4 federally funded shelters across Manitoba.
- There is no charge to access services at these shelters.
- While staying at shelter basic needs are covered such as prescriptions, emergency eye glasses and emergency dental work.
