Recommendations from #Morethanabed

- The number of shelters in Canada must increase due to high turn-away rates and rural and remote womens lack of access to shelter service
- Sustainable core operational funding for shelters is required as well as yearly cost of living increases in accordance with standard of living.
- Canada must fund equal, equitable and culturally appropriate protection from domestic violence to indigenous women.
- The federal government must develop and implement a National Action Plan on Violence against Women so that no matter where she lives in Canada she will have access to service.

60 delegates from across Canada came together in Ottawa May 2 & 3 to discuss the recent report by Women's Shelters Canada on the state of shelters across Canada called More Than a Bed. Angela Braun of Genesis House was fortunate to be chosen as a representative for Manitoba.

Some of the findings that resonated for Manitoba's shelter experience include:

- 31% of residents were unable to find housing during their stay
- 79% of shelters identified complex mental health & addictions as major challenges.
- 61% of shelters identified low pay & benefits as a major challenge to retaining staff
- 74% of shelter identified insufficient funding as a major challenge.


