Fall 2019 Genesis House presented information to 9 community councils in their service area in an effort to increase awareness about domestic abuse and to shed light on some of the challenges facing the agency and the families they serve. Genesis House was seeking support both in leadership to help set a high community standard of behavior and also financial support for the residential program. It has been over 12 years since there has been an increase to the core operating grant from the province. 50 cents per person was requested based on the most recent census data.
